ENTERING PETS (DOGS AND CATS) TO BOLIVIA

Requirements:

1. Pet dogs and cats traveling to Bolivia must have an International Health Certificate for Dogs and Cats, issued by the Canadian Food Inspection Agency. You should download this document from the Agency's website. The document must also be authenticated by the Department of Foreign Affairs-DFAIT (see Legalization of Documents)
2. After this process, the document should be sent to the Consular Section of the Embassy of Bolivia in Ottawa in order for it to be legalized.
3. The consular fee for the legalization of USD 85.00 payable in USD funds by Money Order or Certified Cheque to the "Embassy of Bolivia".
4. If you don't live in Ottawa, please send along with your documents a pre paid self addressed envelope for us to return your documentation
5. In addition, you have to contact your airline company and find out what are the requirements for the transportation of your pet.
